Children's Behavior & Social Stories

October 24, 2018

Social stories are a fun and engaging way to teach children new skills or about a new situation. Come and learn how to create a social story individualized to the needs of all the children in your program or just for one child! We will also explore how children use behavior to communicate. As more children and families in our community are being affected by various traumas, we talk about the difference between challenging behavior and trauma triggers in young children and how similar these may look to us when we are in the classroom.

Communication Boards

February 27, 2019

Attendees will learn about assistive technology (AT). AT is any object or system that increases or maintains the capabilities of people with disabilities. One AT technique is offering children choices through choice boards. We will learn through hands-on material making of choice boards developed with our support or that others have created. We will brainstorm ideas so that you can walk away with a choice board to use in your program.

Self-Regulation

May 22, 2019

Children who learn appropriate ways to self-regulate are able to manage strong emotions, adjust to changes in their environment and build strong friendship skills. This workshop will offer attendees a chance to learn strategies to support children's abilities to self-regulate in an Early Childhood setting. Our Occupational Therapist will provide information and strategies that educators can take back to their programs and implement immediately with the use of visuals and other resources.
